## **Beethoven's Piano Sonata No. 2, "The Tempest"**

It is believed that Beethoven was inspired by Mozart's K. 475 piano sonata. Also providing inspiration was Jan Ladislav Dussek, who's sonata is also quite similar in opening to Beethoven's. Beethoven's 8th piano sonata fits the classical form of the sonata with a few twists thrown in, mainly the introduction material and its reoccurrences before the development and coda.
