But the divinity of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit is one, the glory equal, the majesty equal.

One God, Three Persons The doctrine of the Trinity means that there is one God who eternally exists as three distinct Persons — the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Stated differently, God is one in essence and three in person.

Each is God, but each is a separate "Person." Using the word person is one of the only ways our language has to describe this concept. All three Persons of the Trinity comprise the one, perfectly unified God. The teaching that God is a Trinity is one of the chief false doctrines of the Roman Catholic Church. It is also one of the primary false teachings Protestants took with them when they left the Catholics during the Reformation. The Biblical truth is that the Holy Spirit is the power through which God begets us as his dear children.

Is God a Trinity?

The Jews believe God is Father of all creation (Deuteronomy) and they are His first-born children. (Exodus 4:22) Christians believe in the Holy Trinity, which is one God, operating in three persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Christian Creed (Credo) is a summary of this belief.
