An affidavit is a signed sworn statement and the signer is called the "affiant" or "deponent." To formalize the affidavit, it should be signed in front of an official, such as a notary public. An affidavit and Indemnification agreement is a signed statement in which the affiant agrees to indemnify the holder of the agreement.

A seller's affidavit is virtually identical to a tenant estoppel letter but is signed by the landlord, not the tenant. While this option has its downfalls, e.g., self-interest, and may not fully appease a potential buyer or lender, it is an option for a landlord to consider when a tenant refuses to sign an estoppel letter.
